

INFORMATION CLAUSE**concerning the event 6th ETV Stakeholder Forum (18.06.2024)**

Pursuant to Article 14(1-3) and Article 13(1-2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on the protection of data) (Journal of Laws UE L 119 of 4.5.2016, pp. 1-88) - hereinafter "GDPR" - Institute of Environmental Protection-National Research Institute (hereinafter: "IOŚ-PIB"), as the Personal Data Administrator, informs:

I.

The administrator of your personal data is IOŚ-PIB with its registered seat in Warsaw, 32 Słowicza St., 02-170 Warsaw, entered into the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, XII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000032034. The Director acts on behalf of IOŚ-PIB.

II.

III.

Source of data: website or publicly available databases or electronic correspondence. In the case of data collected directly - the provision of data is a contractual requirement, resulting from the impossibility of registering the participant for the event.

IV.

Personal data will be processed for the purposes of participant registration and reporting referred to above on the basis of your consent. The data will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) - to the extent that you consent to be informed about other events, (b) - to the extent that you sign up for an event and (f) GDPR - to the extent that the controller invites you to participate in an event. The controller will also process your personal data for the purposes of conducting information and promotional activities of IOŚ-PIB, in connection with the organization of events, conferences, workshops, competitions, participation in Projects. The possibility of processing your personal data by IOŚ-PIB allows for sending you information and individualized invitations regarding the above-mentioned events organized within the framework of IOŚ-PIB activity. If you do not agree, please contact the Data Protection Officer and withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, which however does not affect the legality of data processing prior to the withdrawal of consent.

V.

The Administrator will process the following data about you: name, surname, e-mail address, data concerning the institution/organization you represent, legal status of the institution/organization you represent, country, area of expertise, image of the participant recorded during the events organized by the Administrator (as long as it allows the identification of the data subject).

VI.

Legally justified purposes of the administrator: IOŚ-PIB is engaged, among other things, in promoting knowledge about environmental technologies and innovations, as part of which it organizes events to foster knowledge exchange or establishes research cooperation with entities operating in this area. Without the collection of up-to-date data on sector actors and other research activities carried out in the field of environmental technologies and innovations, it is not possible to carry out the activities.

VII.

The following data recipients may have access to the personal data:

Personal data will be accessible to authorized employees, external entities providing and supporting the IOŚ-PIB IT systems, entities providing services related to the current activity of IOŚ-PIB, subcontractors, e.g. accounting, legal and IT companies, suppliers of software necessary to conduct the conference in the on-line system, production companies - within the framework of the fulfilment of their duties resulting from the Agreement between the IOŚ-PIB and a given Partner: -providing that the above-mentioned entities use adequate technical and organizational measures to ensure data protection Personal data will be shared only to the extent that it is absolutely necessary in connection with the concluded Agreement.

VIII.

The controller informs you that it does not intend to transfer your personal data to a third country or to an international organization.

IX.

The data will be processed for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data are processed. In connection with the fact that the purpose of the processing is to carry out the statutory tasks of the Administrator, the data will be used in the continuous work of the Administrator. The data will be updated on an ongoing basis, which means that outdated or incorrect data will be successively supplemented, deleted and modified, at the request of the individual. The individual will have the opportunity to update and correct their data. In order to prevent retention of personal data for longer than necessary, the controller will review the data periodically, at least once a year. Data collected on the basis of an individual's consent will be processed until the individual's consent is withdrawn, which will not affect the lawfulness of processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

X.

In accordance with Articles 7, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21 of the GDPR, unless otherwise provided by the GDPR you have the right to:

1. the right to access and receive a copy of your data and the right to rectification (amendment), erasure, restriction of processing, the right to object to the processed data,
2. the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the legality of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal,
3. the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if it considers that the processing of such personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

XI.

The controller informs you that no automated decision-making or profiling as referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) of the GDPR takes place with regard to your data.
