Environmental Technology Verification (ETV)

ETV is a voluntary scheme that is to provide credible, reliable and independent verification of the performance of innovative environmental technologies (ISO 14034 definition), to:

- √ help technology manufacturers, especially SMEs, market their new technologies
- √ facilitate the implementation of the EU and MS policies and regulations for environment and innovation

ETV in the EU policy context

Explicit reference to ETV scheme is introduced in the following initiatives:

- The Sustainable Consumption and Production and Sustainable Industrial Policy Action Plan (SCP/SIP)

Which technologies are concerned?

Environmental technologies are all technologies (**products**, **processes**, **services**) which:

- √demonstrate environmental added value i.e. more beneficial or less adverse environmental impact with respect to the technologies applied currently in a similar situation
 - e.g. water treatment technologies, biobased products
- **Measure parameters** that indicate environmental impacts
 - e.g. monitoring technologies

- ✓ Technology developers & providers
- ✓ Technology investors
- ✓ Technology purchasers
- ✓ Policymakers
- ✓ Regulators

Costs & funding

- EU and National support schemes exists to support covering the ETV verification costs
- ETV verification is an eligible cost of the collaborative projects Horizon Europe, LIFE...
- Dedicated calls for financial support of ETV verification are published regularly by EIT or other national institutions

ETV in numbers


- ETV pilot programme was running between 2013-2018 in 7 Member States
- ETV programme relaunched in November 2020 with renewed ETV Secretariat
- Applications received: over 200 since 2013 (this number includes applications that were either considered not eligible, finally not conclusive or canceled by the proposer)
- Verified technologies: 49
- Ongoing vérifications : 30
